




# **Use Wireless LAN Network for Internet Connection**

### Precautions.

#### **Care and Recommendations**

The following information is aimed at obtaining the best performance and a long life for your laptop. If you need technical answers or more specialized information, call 52 (662) 10 90 807.

- If you choose to keep your laptop turned on while you are not interacting with it, it is recommended that you activate the screensaver options as well as the energy-saving functions.
- If a power cable is damaged, disconnect it immediately.
- Disconnect the power cables if your device has been exposed to rain or any excessive moisture.
- Disconnect the power cables if the device has fallen or somehow been strongly impacted.
- Disconnect the power cables whenever you clean the device or perform maintenance on it.

### **Cleaning Suggestions**

- Before any cleaning operation, your device must be turned off and preferably disconnected.
- Do not use aerosol liquids, solvents, or abrasives that could damage the finish of your laptop.
- Try not to spill liquids on your keyboard as it can be damaged by anything that leaves sticky residues.

### **Recommended Environment**

Your laptop can tolerate more or less the same temperature that you find comfortable, but do not expose it to direct sunlight, rain, or excessive moisture. Adequate ventilation is very important to extend the life of your laptop. Make sure there are clearances of 10 to 15 cm on both sides and the backside of your device.

### **Transporting the Laptop**

There may be a need to transport the device, either to claim a warranty, change its location, or resell it. In these cases, it is recommended to use the original packaging as it provides the best protection for your device.

### **Service and Professional Support**

Your equipment requires periodic preventive maintenance, for which it is highly recommended to go to the nearest Lanix service center or to your authorized computer distributor.

This service is especially necessary when there is dust and humidity in the normal working environment.
